Electronic Media position: M.F.A. degree (60 credits) in Graphic Design, Design, Electronic Arts, Digital Media Arts, Time-based media or other related field required. This position would be for a technology-based arts instructor to teach courses in Digital Photography, Graphic Design, Introduction to Computer-Based Arts, Computer-based Illustration and Image-Making, Time-based media and/or other related technology-based art classes. Evidence of high quality creative expression and exhibitions record are essential, as well as an ability to advance the Department's commitment to diversity and multiculturalism through research, teaching and outreach with relevant programs, goals and activities. Teaching assignments will be shared between foundations, graphic design and photography. The applicant should have advanced working knowledge of Mac OS X and proficiency and/or experience in software applications such as Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, QuarkXPress, Motion, Dreamweaver, and Flash. This person would be responsible for providing leadership in the management, maintenance and on-going development of the department's Computer Lab, with working knowledge of Mac OS X, a Mac OS X Server based networking environment, hardware installation, software package installation and system roll-out, user data access, working knowledge of laser and inkjet desktop printers and their maintenance, supply purchasing, and equipment maintenance and purchase. Appointment includes service on department and college committees. Teaching experience at the college level is highly desirable.

Rank/Salary: This is an entry-level position. The successful candidate will be appointed untenured and at the rank of Assistant Professor.

Deadline for receipt of completed application: November 30, 2007. Search may be extended if suitable candidate is not identified. Semi-finalists may be asked to submit further evidence of creativity and/or teaching.

To initiate application submit ONLY letter of interest, including teaching philosophy, vita, names, addresses and phone numbers of three references (no letters, please), 20 slides or CD of current art work (including video, modelings, etc.), up to 20 slides or CD of student art work, and SASE for return of materials. Slides must be submitted in clear plastic viewing sheets and each slide must be labeled with applicant's name.
