Pre-entry:

1. Send or deliver completed pre-entry form and fees to: Adams County Fair Entries, 9755 Henderson Road, Brighton, CO 80601 by 4:00 p.m., Friday, July 13, 2012.

Entry Process:

1. Attach entry tags to all pre-entered items. Bring pre-entered items to the Waymire Dome Rendezvous Room on Friday, July 27, 2012, from 4:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
2. No props are allowed due to space limitations.
3. Wine not entered for judging will NOT be allowed.

Judging:

1. Judges reserve the right to move entries from one department or section to another to assure the best possible judging environment for all exhibitors.
2. Wine judging begins at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 28, 2012.
3. We welcome anyone to watch the judging as space allows.

Ribbons awarded in each class:

1st Prize:

Blue Ribbon
Grand Champion
Reserve Champion

2nd Prize:

Red Ribbon

3rd Prize:

White Ribbon

Exhibit Requirements:

1. Exhibitors must be 21 years of age and over.
2. Each homemade wine entry shall consist of one standard wine bottle (750 ml or 5th bottles.)
3. Labels on entries should include only fruit used and date (month and year) that fermentation originated.
4. **No exhibitor's name or additional information, please.**
5. Entry tag must be attached to the bottle with string or rubber band.
6. Entries will be opened for inspection and tasted only by the judge(s).
7. Exhibitors may enter more than one entry per class.
8. Exhibitors must be amateur wine makers, no professional wine makers are allowed to enter.
9. All wine not in the Blue Ribbon or Best of Show categories must be picked up by 5:00 p.m., Saturday, July 28.
10. Blue Ribbon and Best of Show wines will remain on display until Sunday, August 5, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.
11. Winners who remove their entries before 5:00 p.m., Sunday, will forfeit premiums.
12. Entries not picked up by Sunday at 6:00 p.m. will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
