



4-H SMALL ANIMALS DIVISION RULES

GENERAL RULES:

In addition to the rules listed herein, the General Rules for the Adams County Fair will govern the Small Animals Division.

1. 4-H Small Animals entry fees are listed in specific departments.
2. The supervisor and/or clerk must check entries in and out of each department.
3. Entry forms must be turned in at the Extension Office by 4:00 p.m., June 29, 2012.
4. Small animal project year is July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012.
5. Record books must be turned in at the Extension Office by 4:00 p.m., July 13, 2012.
6. In order to sell any animals in the Small Animal Division, exhibitors must score a 70% or above on their small animal record books.
7. Ribbons and premium money will be given through 5th place.
8. Exhibitors are responsible for care and feeding of animals. The exhibitors must supply feed, water, and containers.
9. Exhibitors must be Adams County 4-H members and have ownership and/or management of their project animal's 90 days before the Fair, with the exception of guide dogs and covies. All animals exhibited must be part of the member's project.
10. No exhibitor will be allowed to show without a completed record book signed by the parents and an adult enrolled volunteer leader. (Junior Leader's signatures not acceptable.) The superintendent of the project will sign independent member's books. It is up to the exhibitor to have their book signed before turning it into the office. Records to be in member's own handwriting, or must be member's own work if typed, to be accepted.
11. All protests must be submitted to the superintendent of Small Animals Department in writing and accompanied by a \$50.00 fee.
12. County Fair rules do not necessarily match State Fair rules.
13. If interview judging is required, you must attend the interview to show at the Fair.
14. Misconduct or foul language will not be allowed. Those who do will be told to leave and will forfeit all awards and premiums.
15. To participate in small animal showmanship you must meet all ownership and project requirements.

PREMISES I.D. NUMBER REQUIREMENT:

All animals eligible to participate in the Jr. Livestock Sale and those animals that will be going through the Jr. Livestock Sale will be required to have a Premises I.D. Number. NO EXCEPTIONS.

ALL 4-H exhibitors in all project areas will be issued a wristband and this wristband must be worn in order to show at the Adams County Fair.
