Adams County 4-H Programs Scholarship Rules for scholarship application

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Adams County 4-H Programs Committee has established a fund for educational assistance:

1. The scholarship will be awarded to an Adams County 4-H Club member.
2. Each scholarship given will not exceed \$1000 per person
3. Once the scholarship has been received by an individual, that individual may not reapply.
4. This scholarship is good for any educational opportunity.

Eligibility:

1. The applicant must be an Adams County, Colorado 4-H Club member.
2. The applicant must be a senior in high school.
3. The applicant must have exhibited a 4-H project at the Adams County Fair the year immediately prior to applying for the scholarship.

Anyone meeting the aforementioned requirements, regardless of race, color, sex, national origin or handicap may apply for these scholarships.

Selection:

1. The Programs Committee will select a reviewing committee of three or more people, which will select recipients for the scholarships.

Acceptance:

The recipient shall notify the Treasurer of the Programs Committee of acceptance or refusal of the scholarship in writing by **September 1** of the year they receive the scholarship or the scholarship will be void.

Payment:

1. The scholarship will be announced no later than May 20, and will be presented to the recipient at his/her appropriate school function.
2. The scholarship recipients will be announced at the Annual County 4-H Achievement Banquet.
3. The scholarship will be paid to the educational institution by the Treasurer of the Programs Committee upon proof of entry into the educational institution as evidenced by a course schedule and/or receipt of tuition payment.
