One thousand dollars (\$1,000) will be awarded under the provisions of this offer for any course of study leading to an associate arts or bachelors degree in any accredited junior or senior college in the state of Colorado.

Student Eligibility and Qualifications

1. Before making application for this scholarship, students and parents should understand that to receive payment, the applicant must meet all of the requirements listed in the rules.
2. The winner must use the award the fall term or semester following graduation from high school or it will be transferred to the alternate.
3. Applicants must be seniors in high school whose parents hold a membership and qualify as active patrons of the American Pride Co-op.
4. During the previous 2 years in high school, the applicant must have maintained an accumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 as measured on a 4.0 scale.
5. No student shall be eligible to receive payment for more than 1 American Pride Co-op – Cole Kugel Scholarship.
