BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE

This scholarship fund was set up by the Adams County Extension Homemakers on January 30, 1976 with the cooperation of the CSU Cooperative Extension in Adams County. The purpose is to financially assist Adams County residents to further their education in order to obtain skills and knowledge that are home economics related. It has been funded from donations from Lois Kinsey, friends, fund raisers, businesses, and associates of Lois Kinsey, a 1972 retired Extension Home Economist, Adams County.

Emphasis is on vocational and leadership development to applicants who live in Adams County. It is to assist the person who needs to earn; but, because of changes in life style, lacks the funds or skills to become employed. Selection is based on interest and need, i.e. the person who suddenly has to re-enter the work force, the person who has never been employed, the single parent, or persons with career changes.

ELIGIBILITY

Possible recipients of this scholarship are prioritized as follows, and must be 21+ years and a resident of Adams County for at least 1 year and a citizen of the U.S.A.

1. A man or woman who wishes to further their professional education or receive vocational training in home economics and are in financial need.
2. A dislocated worker or long-term unemployed or a person with diminished marketable skills.

3. A 4-H leader who wishes to attend a leadership development program in a home economics related area.
4. Applicants must submit a completed application form by August 1 and September 1 of the current year.
