### NATIONAL WESTERN SCHOLARSHIP FUND

**HISTORY:** The National Western Scholarship Fund was established in 1983 by The Western Stock Show Association to encourage young men and women with a major interest in the field of agricultural sciences to pursue and complete their education at the university level.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Applicants must be full time high school seniors who intend to major in agricultural sciences. Applicants transferring from Junior College may be considered as high school seniors. Applicants must have a history of participation in the National Western Stock Show and must remain in good academic standing (minimum G.P.A. of 3.0). Other criteria include interest in the livestock industry, leadership and scholastic achievements, need and activities.

**CURRENT SCHOLARSHIPS:** Twelve agri-business scholarships at Colorado State University and four agri-business scholarships at the University of Wyoming. Scholarship recipients are eligible for \$2,000 each of their first three years. If they have successfully completed three years under the scholarship program, they are eligible for \$2,500 their senior year. The recipients are reviewed each year as to their academic standing, continued major in agricultural sciences and ability to graduate within the four year period.

Two \$3,000 Masters of Agriculture in Beef Industry Leadership at Colorado State University.

One \$3,000 NW Livestock Leadership Scholarship at the University of Wyoming.

**SELECTION:** Recipients of the National Western Scholarships shall be selected by the University official designated by the President of the University to administer student financial aids programs at the University.
