How to Submit Samples

- Fill out sample submission form (available on-line and in the office)
- Provide as much detail as possible
- Include healthy and problem plants for comparison.
- Don't add water or wet paper towels
- Wrap roots and soil in a plastic bag to prevent soil from contacting foliage
- Place entire sample loosely in plastic bag
- Pack well if shipping

No Saturday/weekend deliveries
Mail early in the week for best results

2008-2009 Services & Fees

Basic services (per sample)

(CNGA member price/non-member price)

Basic disease or pest ID..... \$15/25

Includes microscopic identification of plant pathogens, pests, and/or environmentally related problems.

Fungal or bacterial culture... \$20*/30*

Includes culturing on selective media to identify fungi and bacteria to the genus/species level.

Virus testing..... variable fee*

Serological based virus identification

(fee dependent on cost of supplies)

*This is a fee added to the basic disease or pest id fee. Additional fees greater than \$20 will be confirmed before proceeding.

Additional services (per sample)

Fungicide resistance screening.....

.....\$40/\$60

Includes fungal isolation from growing media, plant material, or water and screening on fungicide-amended media

On-site consultation

CNGA member..... \$40 + expenses^t

Non-member..... \$70 + expenses^t
