Those eligible must be a high school senior (currently enrolled in 4-H in Larimer or Moffat Counties) or a college, university, or vocational student who has successfully completed three years of 4-H in Larimer or Moffat County. Individuals must have an interest in furthering their education in agriculture and/or agricultural related programs at a higher level.

- c. Two letters of recommendations
- d. A transcript of your grades from each school
