Scholarship: Two \$1,000 Scholarships per year (or 1-\$1,000 and 2 \$500)

Purpose: To provide scholarships for Larimer County Youth who have excelled in “agricultural “ projects and are enrolling in agriculture or an agricultural related program at a college or university.

Scholarship Criteria: Scholarship selection will be based upon the following criteria:

1. Larimer County high school graduating seniors planning to attend a college or university beginning the fall of 2009 and enroll in agriculture or agriculture-related programs.
2. Must have been enrolled as a Larimer County 4-H member as verified by an Extension Agent.
3. Applicant must have enrolled in and completed 4-H projects in agriculture or agriculture-related program.
4. Applicant must complete the Larimer County 4-H Scholarship Application Form (attachment)
5. Selection criteria include:
 - a) Leadership/citizen activities (4-H and community)
 - b) 4-H achievement
 - c) Scholarship potential (cumulative GPA 3.0 on a 4.0 system)
6. Applications are due February 6, 2009 in the Larimer County Extension Office
7. As a follow-up to receiving this scholarship award, recipients will be expected to provide a report (in person, if possible) of their college experience to the Rotary Club of Fort Collins.
8. Preference will be given to Fort Collins area (Northern Larimer County) 4-H youth.
9. Selection shall be made by members of the Rotary Club (Rural-Urban) Committee.

Ask these people to give their recommendations **directly** to you in a sealed envelope and include with your scholarship application. Recommendations should be obtained from the following:

1. A member of your present school faculty or last school attended.
2. One of your 4-H Club leaders.
3. One other person who knows of your character and reputation. (Should not be a current Larimer County 4-H Youth Agent.
