

FASHION REVUE - GUIDELINES

The 2000 Fashion Revue, "Picture Perfect Fashions", is for the following 4-H members:

All Primary Members (Cloverbuds), AND Junior, AND Senior Members enrolled in Clothing, Knitting, Crocheting, Decorate Your Duds, Fashion Focus, and Leathercraft Unit 10.

Junior members will be judged in the afternoon. Primary members will take the stage according to the schedule below. Senior members will be judged in the evening, followed by the public fashion revue and awards for the Junior and Primary members. Then the Seniors will be presented again and awards given to them. Models must be at the evening show to receive special awards. Families and friends are invited to attend the evening revue.

The 2000 Revue will be held at the UNION COLONY CIVIC CENTER MONFORT CONCERT HALL, 651 10TH AVENUE, GREELEY.

NOTE: Food, beverages, gum, and tobacco use are NOT allowed in Monfort Concert Hall.

Note: Decorate Your Duds will be eligible for State Fashion Revue, grouped with Knitting, Crocheting, and Leathercraft. Fashion Focus will not be included in State Fashion Revue.

Up to five places in each of the six junior categories may be awarded. A junior grand champion, reserve grand champion, and runner-up will be named from the first and second places in each category.

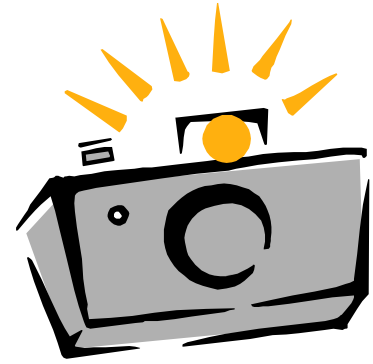
For the evening revue, the order of modeling will be 1) senior, 2) primary, 3) junior, and 4) senior. Models do not need to wear their numbers for the evening show.

"Picture Perfect Fashion"

Please include the following information on your outfit; write the commentary as though someone else is reading it about you as you model: Why did you select your pattern, giving pattern detail that influenced your selection, fabric or yarn, color choice, and where you will wear your outfit. Describe your accessories and any problems you had in constructing your garment that might be interesting to the audience. BE CREATIVE!!! Keep the theme in mind. If possible, please type or use computer - Double space , 12cpi or 12 font size.

Note: "Writing a Commentary" workbook is available through the Extension Office for \$1.00 for members. It gives lots of great ideas on how to write a commentary that really grabs people's attention. Leaders in these project areas can pick up a copy free of charge at the Extension Office.
