## **III. VIDEOS**

1. **Ballad of Narayama** - Based on a Japanese legend and set a century ago, this focuses on a proud matriarch and her widowed son as they prepare for her final journey to Mount Narayama. The intense conflict between love, duty, and harsh reality builds to a chilling, unforgettable climax. Japanese with English subtitles, 129 minutes.
2. **Black Rain** - An unforgettable movie about humanity and survival after the 1945 atomic catastrophe that changed the world forever. Stunning photography vividly details the horror of ravaged Hiroshima, while its shocked survivors struggle with radiation sickness as they rebuild their shattered lives. Japanese with English subtitles, 123 minutes.
3. **Burmese Harp** - A poetic trek across a pain-filled landscape, this powerful antiwar film is a classic example of visual intensity and unyielding pacifism. Set at the close of WWII, this film focuses on the obsessions that drive one

She appears as a beautiful, tiny flower, but looks can be deceiving.

**A Door to the Sky** - By Farida Ben Lyazid (107 mn). Morocco.

- **African Art** - By Aminata Forna (47 mn). When first seen in the Western world in 1900, African Art was viewed as strange and exotic. Yet these works, the booty of colonial wars, would influence Picasso, Matisse, and Modigliani and change the course of 20th-century art.
- **Afrique dominée, Afrique libérée** - Videotape and transcript. This film traces the history of colonialism in Africa. French, 30 minutes.

- **Afrique, je te plumerai** - 2 copies- Overview of 100 years of cultural imperialism in Africa. Case study of the devastation of traditional African societies by colonial cultures: Cameroon: the only country colonized by 3 European powers. French with English subtitles, 88 minutes.
- **L'Age d'Or (Age of Gold)** - No description available. French.
- **Aimé Césaire: Une Voix Pour L'Histoire**
  - **Part I: Île Veilleuse (The Vigilant Island)** - Césaire shows us his pays natale, a tropical crossroads where Europe, Africa and America meet. He discusses the difficulty of balancing poetry and politics for over 50 years. French with English subtitles, 54 minutes.
  - **Part II: Au Rendez-vous de la Conquête** (Where the Edges of Conquest Meet)- 1930s Paris. Senghor, the first president of Senegal, and the French poet Damas developed the concept of negritude, a revindication of African values. French with English subtitles, 56 minutes.
  - **Part III: La Force de Regarder Demain** (The Strength to Face Tomorrow)-Césaire responds to the disappointments of the post-colonial world and expresses his hopes for the future. French with English subtitles, 50 minutes.
- **Antilles: Guadeloupe and Martinique French**, 54 minutes.
- **L'argent** - A stunning protest against greed and corruption. A boy's parents refuse to lend him money, so a friend gives him a counterfeit 500-franc bill. This one act sets into motion a chain of events that will lead to murder. French with English subtitles, 82 minutes.
- **Astérix: Le Gaulois** - Nous sommes en 50 avant Jésus-Christ. Le général romain Caius bonus et ses puissantes troupes font le sié d'un village gaulois. French, 67 minutes.
- **Au revoir les enfants** (2 copies)-Set during the German occupation of France, this is the story of Julien Quentin, a sensitive, 12-year-old boy who befriends the new student in his class. French with English subtitles, 103 minutes.
- **Autumn Tale** - By Eric Rohmer (110 mn). After her children leave home, winegrower Magali (Béatrice Romand) finds her isolated vineyard in the South of France lonely and depressing. But when friends try to set her up with suitable companions, the results are hilarious, heartwarming and totally unpredictable.
- **Baaba Maal: Live at the Royal Festival Hall** - Recorded July 13th, 1998 at London's famed royal Festival Hall, the concert of Senegalese pop superstar Baaba Maal features Baaba Maal's exceptional band Daande Lenöl (Voice Of The People), joined by Jamaican guitar virtuoso Ernest Ranglin and The Screaming Orphans as special guests. DVD, 70+ minutes.
- **Balzac** - A passionate lover of women and the arts, Balzac is both ambitious and excessive. His flamboyant lifestyle is hindered, however, by tremendous personal struggles. Shunned by a demanding mother, disregarded by critics and harassed by debt-collectors, he works relentlessly to save himself from financial ruin. Balzac finds his only solace in letters from the Russian countess Eve Hanska, a married woman whom he will love his entire life. DVD, French with English subtitles, 200 minutes.
- **Battle for Dien Bien Phu** - A portrait of the eight- year struggle for independence, which ended France's Imperial Dream. English,50 minutes.
- **Battle of Algiers** - The struggle a terrorist group to rid their country of French colonialism. French with English subtitles, 125 minutes.

- **Beaumarchais** - An artist whose work influenced the likes of Mozart and Rossini, Beaumarchais the Scoundrel was one of history's most extraordinary figures: inventor, playwright, diplomat, playboy, Royal spy for King Louis XV, and emissary of the colonial attacks against Britain during the American Revolution. French with English subtitles, 100 minutes.
- **Beauty and the Beast**
- **Bed and Board** - The fourth installment in the "Antoine Doinel" series now finds Antoine in his late twenties and married to Christine. While at a new job, Antoine meets Kyoko and falls in love with her. When Christine discovers the affair, Antoine moves out of the house where he must learn to face the responsibilities of adulthood. French with English subtitles, 100 minutes.
- **Black Cat White Cat** - Grga Pitic and Zarije Destanov are two old friends- and rivals- who haven't seen each other in years. But a series of events beyond their wildest dreams leads to a raucously funny reunion filled with gypsy mobsters, dirty deals and shotgun weddings. Serbo-Croatian and Romany language with English subtitles, 129 minutes.
- **Black Orpheus** - It retells the Greek myth of Orpheus and Eurydice against the madness of Carnival in Rio de Janeiro. By Marcel Camus. DVD, Portuguese with optional English subtitles, 107 minutes.
- **Breathless (A bout du souffle)**- Is about a car thief who accidentally shoots a policeman and hides out in an American's apartment. She betrays him to the law, but he still refuses to leave. French with English subtitles, 90 minutes.
- **Bretagne aujourd'hui, La** - video tape and transcript- A view of Brittany today in six vignettes. Perfect for first-year use, others for second-year or civilization courses. French, 28 minutes.
- **Bye Bye** - A tale of 2 young French-Arab brothers dealing with the clash of cultures and generations in Marseilles. French with English subtitles, 107 minutes.
- **Camille Claudel** - A film by Bruno Nuytten. Both an inspiring saga of artistic vision and the haunting story of a doomed romance, Camille Claudel offers a brilliant study of the thin line separating creativity, passion and madness.
- **Candide: Lesson #17**
- **Cérémonie, La** - The Leliévres family hires Sophie, an eccentric but reserved woman who retains the chateau with quiet efficiency. When Sophie befriends Jeanne, a boisterous postal worker with a keen hatred of the Leliévres the two misfits form an insidious and destructive bond, secured by a similar secret past. French with English subtitles, 111 minutes.
- **Chocolat** (2 copies) - Is about the Dalen's family and their life in Cameroon after independence.
- **Frances Dalen** has returned to trace her past. The film is a memoir of life in 1950s colonial Africa. French with English subtitles. 1 hour, 45 minutes.
- **The City of Lost Children** - A gutsy little girl and a sentimental strongman join hearts and hands to save a small boy's dreams from a madman's master plan. DVD, Subtitles in English, French, and Spanish, 112 minutes.
- **Classroom Vignettes: Teaching Language with Video**
- **Colonel Chabert** - Colonel Chabert is back to claim what is rightfully his, but first he must prove he exists. Stunning performances highlight this lushly-photographed and lavishly-produced saga of passion, intrigue and betrayal amidst the splendor of 19th century French society. French with English subtitles, 111 minutes.
- **Conversations entre les jeunes**
- **Coups d'oeil sur Paris** - Videotape and transcript - The first program engages a series of architects and city planners on the topic of controversial,

new architecture of Paris. The second program offers fascinating views of an all but undiscovered Paris. French, 24 minutes.

- **Crabe Tambour, Le** - Depicts naval officers torn by conflicts of friendship, honor, loyalty and a nostalgia for France's colonial past. Centers on the career of "Willsdorf," a Naval officer during the French Vietnam War. French with English subtitles, 130 minutes.
- **Cross My Heart** - When Antoine and Jerome follow their best friend Martin home from school one day, they discover why he has been acting so strange- his mother has been dead for three days and he's been keeping it a secret for fear of being sent to an orphanage. That calls for a pact to preserve Martin's home life at all costs. French with English subtitles, 105 minutes.
- **Cyrano de Bergerac** (1990)-17th century France, gallant swordsman and lonely poet Cyrano admires the beautiful Roxanne from afar. He feels he could never be worthy of such an exquisite woman...let alone tell her how he feels. French with English subtitles, 2 hours, 18 minutes.
- **Daily Life at the Court of Versailles** - Is the story of France and French culture as reflected in Versailles from construction by Louis XIV, to decline under Louis XV, and abandonment by Louis XVI during the Revolution. French with English narration, 60 minutes.
- **Decrocher l'entretien** - One of the "Attention a la démarche" series - with guide-This 2nd in the series follows Richard into the next phase of his job search. French, 21 minutes.
- **Diabolique** - Henri-Georges Clouzot's horror classic is the story of a sadistic headmaster who brutalizes his fragile wife and his headstrong mistress. The two women murder him and dump his body in a swimming pool; when the pool is drained, no corpse is found. DVD, French with optional English subtitles, 116 minutes.
- **Dinner Game** - By Francis Veber (DVD - 81 mn). Pierre and his friends have a standing date for dinner. Every week, they compete to see who can bring the biggest "idiot" to the party. Pierre is sure he's found a winner in the unsuspecting François, a ministry accountant whose hobby is making matchstick models of famous monument.
- **Don Juan** (or if Don Jan were a woman) - A salacious drama about the sexual exploits and conquests of Jeanne told in flashback. She confesses to her priest and cousin that she has sought a life devouring and destroying men because of a traumatic childhood episode: her father died of a heart attack while admonishing her promiscuous behavior. French with English subtitles, 95 minutes.
- **Elevator to the Gallows** - Jeanne Moreau plays a woman waiting for her lover to return from murdering her husband . . . but their "perfect crime" goes spectacularly wrong. French with English subtitles, 87 minutes.
- **Entre Amis: Les Improvisations** (1990) - 16 short improvs present gestures, in typical language situations, which accompany French speech. French.
- **Entre Nous** - The rare friendship between two married women trying to find the courage to defy the social rules of their time in order to escape their unfulfilling lives. Their friendship blossoms over the years as each faces a succession of crises that greatly alter their lives. DVD, French with English subtitles, 112 minutes.
- **Eye of Vichy** - A film by Claude Chabrol. From the small town of Vichy in Central France, Field Marshall Petain's puppet government worked with their Nazi overlords in creating pro-Nazi propaganda.

- **Femmes Aux Yeux Ouverts** - Portraits of contemporary African women from: Burkina Faso, Mali, Senegal, and Benin and demonstrates why Africa's development is linked to the social/economic progress of its women. French with English subtitles, 52 minutes.
- **First Name: Carmen** - Carmen seduces a policeman who tries to arrest her. They hide out with her Uncle Jean, a burned-out filmmaker. French with English subtitles, 85 minutes.
- **Flame** - Is the story of two friends, who in 1975 join the Chimurenga, the Zimbabwean freedom struggle in Mozambique. Their involvement leads to different outcomes. English, 85 minutes.
- **Francophonie sénégalaise, La** - Videotape and transcript- through interviews with politicians, businesspeople and common people in Dakar, Senegal, the film shows how French has now become the language of everyday life. French, 30 minutes.
- **French TV Commercials** - V. 1 & 2 French, 30 minutes per volume.
- **French Twist** - Saucy suburban housewife Loli is furious when she discovers her playboy husband is a wild womanizer who has been cheating on her for years. English with French subtitles, 100 minutes.
- **French Revolution Reconsidered** - Paris, the eve of Bastille Day. A look at if things have changed or whether it is true that "plus ça change, plus c'est la même chose." French, 52 minutes.
- **Germinal** - A film by Claude Berri (166 mn). Based on the novel of Emile Zola. Gerard Depardieu stars in an epic masterpiece from the director of Jean de Florette and Manon of the Spring. With the broad scope of Charles Dickens and the emotional immediacy of today's news, Germinal tells the story of a miner's strike which destroys one family, yet plants the seeds of change for future generations. Passionately acted and beautifully filmed, Germinal is "extremely powerful and gripping. A great film!"
- **Indochine** - French Indochina. The adopted Indochinese daughter of the owner of a rubber plantation falls in love with her mother's secret lover. The lovers' triangle threatens to destroy the family. French with English subtitles, 156 minutes.
- **Jacques Brel** - Is a portrait of the life and music of the French composer-singer. English, 58 minutes.
- **J'ai Ete Au Bal** - This features Cajun and Zydeco Music of Louisiana.
- **Jean-Marie LeClezio** - No description available. French, 50 minutes.
- **Jesus of Montreal** - A troupe of underemployed actors joins a young man to help a church update its annual Passion Play.
- **Joan of Arc** - This portrait of Jeanne d'Arc (1412-1431) shows how this 15th-century French peasant girl became a leader and a heroine in the battle to lift the British siege of Orléans. English, 11 minutes.
- **Keita: The Heritage of the Griot** - Intro to The Sundjata Epic. A master griot arrives at the home of a young African to teach him "the meaning of his name." Boy and griot conflict with his westernized mother and schoolteacher. In Jula and French with English subtitles, 94 minutes.
- **Krik? Krak!** - The story of Haiti's misery under two generations of Duvaliers is told mingling documents of daily life and scenes from fiction films. French with English subtitles, 78 minutes.
- **L'afrique Noire Francophone** - Aspects divers - With text French, 22.5 minutes.
- **L'afrique Noire Francophone** - géographie politique - With text French, 48 minutes.

- **L'entretien d'embauche** - One of the "Attention a la démarche" series - with guide-This final program recaps the first two, then follows a young woman through the interview process. French, 21 minutes.
- **L'histoire Immédiate** - Based on La Nouvelle France, it portrays major shifts in traditional values: the decline of the Church, the disappearance of the classe ouvrière, the break-up of the traditional family structure and the influx of immigrants in France. French 95 minutes.
- **Le Bourgeois Gentilhomme (The Would-Be Gentleman)**. No description available. French with English subtitles, 97 minutes.
- **Leopold Sedar Senghor** - Senegalese poet, writer, and former president. He was an eulogist of African traditions and Francophone culture. In this homage to him, a young rapper reads and sings the poet's words, illuminating Senghor's images of Africa. French, 50 minutes.
- **Les Bretons chez eux** - This collection of 20 segments, for use at the introductory level. The segments depict various aspects of life in the small towns of Brittany. French, 58 minutes.
- **Les buerettes video** - These young women born in France of North African parents, face the two halves of their lives: their identities as modern-day French women contrast starkly with their roles as daughters in traditional Arab families. French, 20 minutes.
- **Les Clips Francophones** - with cassette and guide
- **Les Miserables XX Siecle** - The Nazis occupy France and miserable times begin. It's not so miserable that a good man can't triumph. French with English subtitles, 175 minutes.
- **Lettre de la Martinique** - videotape and transcript- An engaging documentary on this Caribbean departement d'outre-mer narrated by a Martiniquais boy as a letter to his cousin in France, the video follows him through his daily routine describing life in Martinique. French, 17 minutes.
- **Life is a Long Quiet River** - This comedic film centers on the abrupt collision of two very different families. An act of revenge uncovers the fact that 12 years ago their babies were switched at birth and the 2 families are plunged into chaos. French with English subtitles, 89 minutes.
- **Marguerite Duras** - From the program Apostrophes. Bernard Pivot interviews one of France's most important literary figures: Marguerite Duras. French, 76 minutes.
- **Ma Vie en Rose** - A unique film about difference, rejection, and childlike faith in miracles through the eyes of a child who believes he was meant to be a little girl. French with English subtitles, 89 minutes.
- **May Fools (Milou en Mai)** - In this comedic tale, it's all greedy hands for themselves as scrounging, back-stabbing relatives fight over prized family heirlooms. Taming this unruly gang is left up to the loyal and righteous son, Milou. French with English subtitles, 1 hour 49 minutes.
- **Mémoires d'immigrés: l'Héritage Maghrébin (Parts 1 and 2)**
- **Moderato Cantabile** - Anne Desbordes is the young wife of an industrial baron. A violent crime is committed in a café. She goes to the café and meets an employee of her husband, Chauvin. She becomes obsessed, as she equates herself with the victim of the passionate crime.
- **Mon oncle Antoine** - Is a film about a young boy's coming of age in a depressed mining town. French with English subtitles, 104 minutes.
- **Monday's Girls** - This examines the Iria, a women's initiation ceremony of the Niger River delta, through the contrasting viewpoints of two young women. In Waikiriki and English with English subtitles.

- **Monet: Legacy of light** - Portrays Monet's story using his own words with excerpts from journals and personal interviews. English, 50 minutes.
