It was designed and constructed to meet LEED Gold certification standards, features being considered in the early design phase include 3 atriums for daylighting, water efficient landscape, use of renewable energy systems, partial green roof and local materials.

The program will be expanding in the Fall and will run four afternoons/evenings a week, with 120 undergraduates and community adolescents participating. Psychology had 70 undergraduates apply to be mentors in the Fall. Dr. Tracy Richards will continue to serve as the Psychology Partner for this project. Campus Corps was highlighted in the Spring edition of the "Service-Learning Link" newsletter published by The Office of Service-Learning.

Dr. Silvia Sara Canetto was invited to join the Presidential Suicide Prevention Special Task Group of the Society for Counseling Psychology, American Psychological Association. As part of her contribution to the Presidential Suicide Prevention Special Task Group she will deliver an invited presentation on Gender and suicidal behavior around the world at the 2010 San Diego meeting of American Psychological Association.
