**2004 WATERING RESTRICTION SCHEDULE**

This summer, East Cherry Creek Valley Water and Sanitation District will continue its cautious approach to water management practices. Watering restrictions will continue in 2004, along with a continued emphasis on conservation. ECCV's Board of Directors at its February 12<sup>th</sup> meeting proposed a fixed watering schedule rather than readjusting each month.

Starting April 1, ECCV customers may water two days per week, with no watering between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. To accommodate different sized lots, ECCV will allow watering of 15 minutes per zone. ECCV personnel will continue to cite customers who do not adhere to the restrictions, with fines starting at \$100 for the second offense and up.

Hand-watering of trees and shrubs is recommended to ensure the health of these plants.

<b>Residential</b>	2 days per week - Odd numbered addresses may water Wed. & Sat. - Even numbered addresses may water Thurs. & Sun.
<b>Duration</b>	15 minutes per zone
<b>Hours</b>	No watering 10 am - 6 pm
<b>New Sod</b>	None May 15-Sept. 15
<b>Starting</b>	April 1, two days/week
<b>Monitors</b>	Yes
<b>Fines</b>	Yes

The reason for the District's conservative stance is its unique water-supply position. Drawing most of its water from underground aquifers, ECCV's biggest challenge is meeting the high demand during peak watering days. Delivering water in the hottest summer months is more difficult, because water sometimes cannot be pumped fast enough on high-demand days. In addition, as aquifer water is continually pumped and levels decline, pumping rates decline and it costs more money to remove the water that's left. Watering schedules are proven to be an effective way to manage peak demands.

East Cherry Creek Valley Water and Sanitation District's monthly residential water use rates and fees in 2004 are as follows:
