For the Community of Pueblo
Effective April 16, 2003

Watering Days

Landscape watering may take place on any day of the week. Irrigating established lawns two times per week with $\frac{3}{4}$ " to 1" of application on each of those days encourages deep root growth and drought tolerance in lawns.

More frequent watering leads to shallow root growth and results in turf that is more fragile during the heat of summer.

Watering Hours

Watering during the heat of the day wastes from 30% to 50% of your water to evaporation.

We strongly recommend NO WATERING BETWEEN 10 A.M. AND 6 P.M.

Stage I Wise Use Guidelines

1. Vehicle washing at residences should take place only with a bucket and a shut-off nozzle on the hose.
2. Wasting water by causing significant run-off of water onto streets or into drainage facilities is prohibited.
3. Fountains and ponds should, whenever possible, recirculate their water.
4. The most efficient watering of flowers, flower beds, trees, shrubs, and vegetable and herb gardens can be achieved with the use of a drip irrigation system.

We recommend no watering between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.
