Scores on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).	Admissions Office	The minimum TOEFL score for unconditional admission is 213 (computer-based), 550 (paper-based), or 80 (internet-based). Official scores, taken within two years prior to admission, must be submitted directly from the Educational Testing Service. Students are exempted from the TOEFL requirement if the official language of their country is English or if they have recently earned a degree at an American university. ILTS scores are acceptable in addition to TOEFL scores as proof of English proficiency.
