Exceptional Achievement in Service-Learning Faculty Award

Brett Bruyere, '00, '03

Human Dimensions of Natural Resources

Brett Bruyere, Ph.D., has a simple educational philosophy: Hands-on learning makes all the difference. “It seems to me that if students can roll up their sleeves and get experience they can reflect on, that’s how they really acquire the knowledge they will need to succeed,” he said. “There are a lot of benefits to students being part of the community, and knowing that the community extends beyond the campus boundaries.”

Bruyere, an Assistant Professor in the Warner College of Natural Resources and winner of the Exceptional Achievement in Service-Learning Faculty Award, relishes the opportunity to give students real-world experience. He has been the Director of Colorado State University’s renowned Environmental Learning Center (ELC) since 2002, providing the community with hands-on opportunities to learn about nature. At the same time, Bruyere incorporates the ELC into his classes and research.

Something Bruyere is most proud of is working with Colorado State’s Student Leadership, Involvement and Community Education (SLiCE) office to establish annual 16-day alternative breaks for 12 students in Kenya. While there, students participate in projects ranging from school improvement to wildlife counts. They also spend time in the women’s village of Uomja, helping residents improve schools and their cooperative lifestyle.

“To be able to facilitate these experiences for students, most of which are life-changing, is extremely rewarding,” Bruyere said. ■

"I emphasize to my students that I believe in them, because I don't think young people hear that often enough. That's what makes the difference," she said. "If they believe in themselves, they then have the courage to become successful leaders." ■

Advisor Gratitude Award

Linda Stoddard

Pre-Physical Therapy Club and Pre-Occupational Club

Linda Stoddard has spent the past 20 years of her life dedicated to the students at Colorado State University.

Stoddard, this year's recipient of the Advisor Gratitude Award, is a Health Professions advisor in the Center for Advising and Student Achievement (CASA), and faculty advisor for three student organizations: Pre-Occupational Therapy, Pre-Physical Therapy, and Pre-Pharmacy.

A change from intra-university advising to working within Health Professions 2½ years ago opened Stoddard's eyes to the evolving world of health care. "The health professions fields are so wide open for students today," she said. "I'm very lucky because the students I work with are very independent; they are really focused. It's an exciting place to be."

Stoddard received her B.S. and M.S. from Colorado State's Department of Human Development and Family Studies in the College of Applied Human Sciences. Her first ten years on campus after earning her master's were as the coordinator of experiential learning for the Department of Human Development and Family Studies. The last ten years have been with CASA.

Her award may be for her advising talent, but Stoddard said she believes she benefits from working with students as much as they benefit from working with her. "Working with the students and the student organizations is just precious to me because I get to work so closely with them and get to know them so well," she said. ■

Josie Traub-Dargatz, professor of Clinical Sciences, is celebrating 25 years at CSU. Her specialty is equine internal medicine and control of infectious equine diseases. “My most satisfying career aspects include being able to do research that benefited the horse; teaching veterinary students both in the classroom and the veterinary teaching hospital; training of graduate students and veterinary residents; and developing messages for the equine industry related to control on infectious equine diseases.”

Traub-Dargatz’s most memorable moments at CSU include: the formation and accomplishments of the Animal Population Health Institute; the success of PVM and veterinary graduates, with whom she maintains communication; receiving honorable mentions for teaching and research accomplishments; and induction into the Glover Hall of Fame. ■
