


Nation-Wide Opportunity for Art and/or Education Internship Mel Chin Studio



Directed by Mel Chin Studio, OPERATION PAYDIRT is an art, science, and education collaboration supporting a city-wide plan to help end childhood lead poisoning in New Orleans. The project strategy involves both a science driven urban planning effort in New Orleans and a nation-wide collective artwork, THE FUNDRED DOLLAR BILL PROJECT, made of millions of drawings.

Mel Chin Studio is interviewing for FUNDRED interns to participate in community development campaigns across the country. This internship is designed for you to work within your own community/region as a representative of this national project. Good candidates for this internship opportunity include college students, recent graduates, and/or other community members with an interest in the following:

- **Art**
- **Art Education**
- **General Education**
- **Social Justice, Service Learning**
- **Activism**
- **Community Development**
- **Public Relations**

Interns will work closely with Mel Chin's FUNDRED National Coordinator and Assistant Coordinator supporting project outreach by catalyzing and maintaining communications with regional participants. As community development is often a team effort, we will accept applications by two or more persons interested in approaching a specific region collaboratively.

Time commitment: **10-15 hrs/week during Summer 2009, Fall 2009, and/or Spring 2010**
Compensation: **Unpaid, with potential for transitioning to paid positions.**
Academic credit can be arranged with an intern's college or university.
