ADMISSION PROCESS

Admission to the Intensive English Program is open to any student over the age of 17 who has completed high school and can use the English alphabet. To apply, please send:

1. Completed application form
2. Certified letter of financial support (from bank or sponsor)
3. Copy of passport
4. Certification of completion of high school
5. US\$125 application fee (non-refundable)

The application fee can be paid by cash, check or credit card (American Express, MasterCard, Visa). If paying by credit card, please mail or fax the form below. **Do not email this information – we cannot receive credit card information by email.**

If you are transferring from another school in the US, please provide a copy of your visa, I-94 and current I-20 form.

When the completed application has been approved, an I-20 immigration form will be issued. This form allows the student to apply for the F-1 student visa. Incomplete applications cannot be processed. **All** of the above five items must be sent to:
