Seven-Week Courses

Beginning through Advanced Proficiency

May 8 – June 29, 2012

Cost: \$1950 - \$2675 plus fees (based on the number of classes and level)

The Seven-Week Intensive Courses offer a complete sequenced language program: speaking, listening, reading, writing, and grammar. Experienced teachers direct the students' study for maximum progress. Classes are taught at five levels of proficiency and meet for approximately 20 to 25 hours per week. Courses are designed for students who are preparing for academic study and for those with business and professional language goals.

Selected Topic Course - *Advanced Proficiency*

Pronunciation: This course focuses on the students' pronunciation needs. Through whole class, small group and individual sessions, student pronunciation is diagnosed. Through class activities, audiotape and CD ROM assignments, students work on individual assignments to improve their pronunciation.

Please note: All new students must take the IEP placement exam to determine their English proficiency level.

Four-Week Intersession

Beginning through Advanced Proficiency

July 3 - August 3, 2012

IEP Prep - Beginning Proficiency

In this course, an all-skills approach is used in teaching beginning English. The class combines speaking, listening, reading, writing and grammar.

Cost: \$1025 plus fees - 15 hours/week

Language Development – Intermediate Proficiency

This course is designed to give students an opportunity to develop their reading, writing, grammar, and listening/speaking skills while studying about American culture.

Cost: \$1025 plus fees - 15 hours/week

The Other Side of American Culture – Advanced Proficiency

This is a non-traditional listening/speaking course in which students explore aspects of American culture that are often overlooked in traditional classes. Classroom activities and assignments are enhanced by field trips related to the curriculum.

Cost: \$1025 plus fees - 15 hours/week
