



Instrumental Rehearsal Hall

- The Instrument Rehearsal Hall can accommodate the entire 240 person CSU Marching Band. This means no more rain soaked, hot and cold and dark practices for our tremendously talented band members.
- There is a large instrument storage area that allows the faculty and students to have instant access to chairs, stands, and a vast array of percussion instruments according to the needs of the class.
- The space is outfitted with technical needs like a projector and screen, numerous speakers and recording equipment. There is a camera for recording conducting students and other class presentations. The marching band can finally study videos of their performances on a large screen.
- There are acoustic panels throughout the room and in the ceiling to create optimal acoustics setting for any group practicing or performing. The beautiful maple floor provides the same type of acoustic response as the Concert Hall. The acoustics are adjustable with the curtain so that the room can accommodate an orchestra, concert band, or marching band.
- The room is 4,800 square feet with a 40 foot ceiling. This cubic space is what is needed to accommodate large ensembles like the marching band or a full orchestra with chorus.
